

# Internal Messaging Improvements

### What is it?

We have made some improvements around the Internal Messaging area of the system.

#### **Minimise Internal Messaging Windows**

It is now possible to minimise Internal Message windows. This allows users to continue navigating the system whilst typing a message.

For example, if a user is typing a new message, they may want to link a patient/client to the message. Therefore, they could navigate to the reception screen, 'add a link' to the message.

To minimise the message window, select the icon highlighted below:

#### **Workflow Improvements**

Improvements to the useability of the system have also been made around the default cursor focus for screens within the Messaging module.

#### **Reply to Message**

When you 'reply' to a message, the cursor now defaults to the text box rather than the 'To' field.

#### Delete Message Cursor Focus

When you choose to delete a message, the prompt 'Do you want to delete selected message?' will appear. The cursor focus is now set to 'Yes', therefore pressing the **Return Key** on the keyboard will select 'Yes' to delete the message. Alternatively, press **Y** for yes or **N** for 'No'.
